FREDERICK APTOWITZ, M.D., being duly sworn, deposes and says:

On or about March 16, 1965, I was licensed to practice as a physician in the State of New York having been issued License No. 093865 by the New York State Education Department.

I am not currently registered with the New York State Education Department to practice as a physician in the State of New York. My current address is 28975 Walnut Grove, Southfield, Michigan 48034.

I understand that I have been charged with one specification of professional misconduct as set forth in the Statement of Charges, annexed hereto, made a part hereof, and marked as Exhibit "A".

I am applying to the State Board of Professional Medical Conduct for permission to surrender my license as a physician in

the State of New York on the grounds that I admit that I have been convicted of an act which would constitute a crime under the law of another jurisdiction which if committed within the state would have constituted a crime under New York law, as set forth in the specification of professional misconduct set forth in the Statement of Charges.

I hereby make this application to the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct and request that it be granted.

I understand that, in the event that the application is not granted by the State Board of Professional Medical Conduct, nothing contained herein shall be binding upon me or construed to be an admission of any act of misconduct alleged or charged against me, such application shall not be used against me in any way, and shall be kept in strict confidence during the pendency of the professional misconduct disciplinary proceeding; and such denial by the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct shall be made without prejudice to the continuance of any disciplinary proceeding and the final determination by a Committee on Professional Medical Conduct pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Law.

I agree that in the event that the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct grants my application, an order shall be issued striking my name from the roster of physicians in the State of New York without further notice to me.

I am making this Application of my own free will and accord and not under duress, compulsion, or restraint of any kind or manner.

FREDERICK APTOWITZ, M.D., the Respondent, was authorized to practice medicine in New York State on March 16, 1965, by the issuance of license number 093865 by the New York State Education Department. The Respondent is not currently registered with the New York State Education Department to practice medicine in New York State. Respondent's last known address is 28975 Walnut Grove, Southfield, Michigan 48034.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

A. By entry of judgement dated November 16, 1993, Respondent was convicted in the Criminal Court of Warren County, Tennessee, of the crime of solicitation to commit first degree murder on entry of his plea of guilty.

B. The act constituting the crime in Tennessee would, if committed within this state, have constituted a crime under New York State law, namely: criminal solicitation of murder or manslaughter in violation of New York Penal Law Sections 100.05, 100.10, 125.20, and/or 125.25.

SPECIFICATION OF MISCONDUCT

Respondent is charged with professional misconduct within the meaning of New York Education Law §6530(9)(a)(iii)(McKinney Supp. 1994) in that he has been convicted of committing an act constituting a crime under the law of another jurisdiction which, if committed within the state, would have constituted a crime under New York State law, in that Petitioner charges:
