SUMMARY
ORDER

TO: LOREN JOHN BORUD, M.D.

The undersigned, Richard F. Daines, M.D., Commissioner of Health, pursuant to New York Public Health Law §230, upon the recommendation of a Committee on Professional Medical Conduct of the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct, has determined that the duly authorized professional disciplinary agency of another jurisdiction, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Board of Registry in Medicine (hereinafter "Massachusetts Board"), has made a finding substantially equivalent to a finding that the practice of medicine by **LOREN JOHN BORUD, M.D.**, Respondent, New York license number 206400, in that jurisdiction, constitutes an imminent danger to the health of its people, as is more fully set forth in the Order of Temporary Suspension, dated July 23, 2008, attached, hereto, as Appendix "A," and made a part, hereof.

It is, therefore:

ORDERED, pursuant to New York Public Health Law §230(12)(b), that effective immediately, **LOREN JOHN BORUD, M.D.** shall not practice medicine in the State of New York or in any other jurisdiction where that practice is predicated on a valid New York State license to practice medicine.

ANY PRACTICE OF MEDICINE IN THE STATE OF NEW YORK IN VIOLATION OF THIS ORDER SHALL CONSTITUTE PROFESSIONAL MISCONDUCT WITHIN THE MEANING OF NEW YORK EDUCATION LAW §6530(29) AND MAY CONSTITUTE UNAUTHORIZED MEDICAL PRACTICE, A FELONY DEFINED BY NEW YORK EDUCATION LAW §6512.

This Order shall remain in effect until the final conclusion of a hearing which shall commence within thirty (30) days after the final conclusion of the disciplinary proceeding in Massachusetts.

The hearing will be held pursuant to the provisions of New York Public Health Law §230, and New York State Administrative Procedure Act §§301-307 and 401. The hearing will be conducted before a committee on professional conduct of the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct on a date and at a location to be set forth in a written Notice of Referral Proceeding to be provided to Respondent after the final conclusion of the Massachusetts proceeding. Said written Notice may be provided in person, by mail or by other means. If Respondent wishes to be provided said written notice at an address other than that set forth above, Respondent shall so notify, in writing, both the attorney whose name is set forth in this Order, and the Director of the Office of Professional Medical Conduct, at the addresses set forth below.

Respondent shall notify the Director of the Office of Professional Medical Conduct, New York State Department of Health, 433 River Street, Suite 303, Troy, NY 12180-2299, via Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested, of the final conclusion of the proceeding immediately upon such conclusion.

THESE PROCEEDINGS MAY RESULT IN A DETERMINATION THAT YOUR LICENSE TO PRACTICE MEDICINE IN NEW YORK STATE BE REVOKED OR SUSPENDED AND/OR THAT YOU BE FINED OR SUBJECT TO OTHER SANCTIONS SET FORTH IN NEW YORK PUBLIC HEALTH LAW §230-A. YOU ARE URGED TO OBTAIN AN ATTORNEY TO REPRESENT YOU IN THIS MATTER.

ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure Governing Disciplinary Proceedings of the Board of Registration in Medicine, 243 CMR 1.03(11)(a), the Board of Registration in Medicine (Board) ORDERS that

The certificate of registration to practice medicine in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts of LOREN J. BORUD, M.D., Registration No. 205572, is SUSPENDED effective immediately. LOREN J. BORUD, M.D. must cease the practice of medicine immediately, and he is directed to surrender his wallet card and wall certificate to the Board forthwith.

The Board has determined that, based upon the information set forth in the Motion for Summary Suspension, the health, safety, and welfare of the public necessitates said suspension.

The Respondent shall provide a copy of this Order of Suspension within twenty-four (24) hours to the following designated entities: any in- or out-of-state hospital, nursing home, clinic, other licensed facility, or municipal, state, or federal facility at which he practices medicine; any in- or out-of-state health maintenance organization with whom he has privileges or any other kind of association; any state agency, in- or out-of-state, with which he has a provider contract; any in- or out-of-state medical employer, whether or not he practices medicine there; and the state licensing boards of all states in which he has any kind of license to practice medicine; Drug Enforcement Administration Boston Diversion Group; and the Bureau of Health Care Safety and Quality, Massachusetts Department of Public Health. The Respondent is further directed to certify to the Board within forty-eight (48) hours that he has complied with this directive.
