

INTERIM ORDER

I have reviewed the Recommendation of the Hearing Committee on the issue of Imminent Danger in this matter wherein the Committee found that **ARNOLD H. ZUCKER, M.D.**, Respondent, presents an imminent danger to the health of the people of the State of New York, and the Hearing Committee's recommended action that the Summary Order prohibiting **ARNOLD H. ZUCKER, M.D.**, from practicing medicine in the State of New York remain in effect.

Now, upon reading and filing the transcript of the hearing, the exhibits, and other evidence introduced at the hearing, the conclusions and recommendations of the Hearing Committee as set forth in the Recommendation, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part of this Order,

I HEREBY ORDER THAT:

The Summary Order, dated March 10, 2000, imposed upon Respondent, **ARNOLD H. ZUCKER, M.D.**, shall remain in effect, pending the final resolution of this matter.

RECOMMENDATION

MICHAEL R. GOLDING, M.D., Chairperson, NAOMI GOLDSTEIN, M.D., and DANIEL W. MORRISSEY, O.P., duly designated members of the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct, served as the Hearing Committee in this matter pursuant to § 230(10)(e) and (12) of the Public Health Law. DENNIS T. BERNSTEIN, ESQ., ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE, served as Administrative Officer for the Hearing Committee.

After hearing evidence presented by both the Office of Professional Medical Conduct and the Respondent on the issue of whether the Respondent's practice of medicine in the State of New York constitutes an imminent danger to the health of the people, the Hearing Committee unanimously finds that the Respondent's practice of medicine in the State of New York constitutes an imminent danger to the public health, and the Hearing Committee unanimously recommends that the Summary Order suspending the Respondent's license to practice medicine be left in effect.
