
I am applying to the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct for permission to surrender my license as a physician in the State of New York effective December 17, 1994.







JULES GLASHOW, M.D., the Respondent, was authorized to practice medicine in New York State on June 27, 1946 by the issuance of license number 044670 by the New York State Education Department. The Respondent is currently registered with the New York State Education Department to practice medicine for the period from January 1, 1994 to December 31, 1994 at 1625 Saint Peters Avenue, Bronx, New York 10461.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

A. Patient A (more fully identified in Appendix A) was admitted to Westchester Square Medical Center, Bronx, New York under Respondent's surgical care and underwent an open biopsy of the left parotid gland on or about July 22, 1992.  
Respondent:

1. Performed an open biopsy instead of a needle biopsy as indicated.

2. While performing an open biopsy of the parotid gland, failed to define the facial nerve.
3. Upon closure of the incision following open biopsy, failed to place a drain in the wound.
4. Failed to treat post-operative ecchymoses at the wound site in a timely manner.

B. Patient B (more fully identified in Appendix A) was admitted to Westchester Square Medical Center under Respondent's surgical care and underwent an endoscopic open biopsy on or about June 13, 1989. Patient B was readmitted under Respondent's surgical care and underwent an exploratory neck dissection with biopsy on or about June 28, 1989. Respondent:

1. Performed an open biopsy instead of a needle biopsy as indicated on June 13, 1989.
2. Failed to detect tumor of pharynx intraoperatively on June 13, 1989.
3. Failed to continue investigation as indicated when biopsy results were inconsistent with Patient B's condition.
