ORDERED, that the application and the provisions thereof are hereby adopted; it is further


ORDERED, that the name of Respondent be stricken from the roster of physicians in the State of New York; it is further

marked as Exhibit "A".



I hereby make this application to the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct and request that it be granted.


I understand that, in the event that the application is not granted by the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct, nothing contained herein shall be binding upon me or construed to be an admission of any act of misconduct alleged or charged against me, such application shall not be used against me in any way, and shall be kept in strict confidence during the pendency of the professional misconduct disciplinary proceeding; and such denial by the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct shall be made without prejudice to the continuance of any disciplinary proceeding and the final determination by a Committee on Professional Medical Conduct pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Law.

I agree that in the event the State Board for Professional Medical Conduct grants my application, an order shall be issued striking my name from the roster of physicians in the State of New York without further notice to me.

I am making this Application of my own free will and accord and not under duress, compulsion, or restraint of any kind or manner.

A. KAREN KREUTNER, M.D., the Respondent, was authorized to practice medicine in New York State on April 25, 1966, by the issuance of license number 096414 by the New York State Education Department. The Respondent is not currently registered with the New York State Education Department to practice medicine. Respondent's last registered address with the New York State Education Department was 190 Genesee Park Boulevard, Rochester, New York 14619.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

A. By Final Order dated February 7, 1989, the State Board of Medical Examiners of the State of South Carolina concluded that Respondent was guilty of misconduct, in that:

1. The Respondent was found to have practiced medicine while impaired by mental disability.
2. Respondent's treatment of three Patients was below the standard of care expected of competent medical practitioners in similar situations.

Exhibit A

3. The conduct in paragraphs A.1 and/or A.2, if committed in New York State would constitute professional misconduct under the laws of New York State, to wit: practicing the profession while impaired by mental disability [(N.Y. Educ. Law §6530 (7) (McKinney Supp. 1992)]; practicing the profession with negligence on more than one occasion [N.Y. Educ. Law §6530(3) (McKinney Supp. 1992)]; practicing the profession with incompetence on more than one occasion [N.Y. Educ. Law §6530(5) (McKinney Supp. 1992)].

SPECIFICATION

Respondent is charged with professional misconduct under N.Y. Educ. Law §6530(9)(b) (McKinney 1992) [formerly N.Y. Educ. Law §6509(5)(b)] in that Respondent has been found guilty of improper professional practice or professional misconduct by a duly authorized disciplinary agency of another state where the conduct upon which the finding was based would, if committed in New York state, constitute professional misconduct under the laws of New York state, in that Petitioner charges:

1. The facts of paragraphs A and A.1 and A.3, and/or A and A.2 and A.3.
